## **Management Systems**

- Implement management systems, as our ISO 14001certified system, and procedures specifically designed to
  prevent activities and/or conditions that threaten human health, safety, or the environment. (Ref. Hazard
  Communication Program and Safe Work Procedures).
- Continually monitor and comply with all applicable laws, regulations, and established EHS standards related to
  health, safety, and environmental protection. Compliance with EHS quality programs will be a crucial ingredient in
  employee training.
- Establish and meet our own EHS quality standards where existing laws and regulations are not adequate to assure the protection of human health, safety, and the environment. (Ref. Safety Committee Program)

## Pollution Prevention & Risk Management

- Integrate safety and environmental protection measures into design, development, and manufacturing processes to maintain a competitive, quality product that minimizes cost and waste.
- Minimize risk and protect our employees and the communities in which we operate by employing safe technologies and operating procedures, as well as being prepared for emergencies (Ref. Emergency Response Policies)
- Strive to prevent releases to the atmosphere, land, or water. Minimize the amount and toxicity of waste generated
  and ensure the safe treatment and disposal of all waste. (Ref. Hazard Communication Program)
